'Room In The Inn' Opens New Facility For Homeless

NASHVILLE, Tenn. - Nashville's homeless community have a new place to go.

Room in the Inn opened its doors to the community Thursday, showcasing the group's new \$13 million multi-purpose facility on 8th Avenue.

It houses several new additions including a state of the art 13 classroom learning center as well as expanded care for those recovering from medical illnesses or injuries.

For the first time in history, Room in the Inn will offer 38 affordable housing apartments.

"They're 500 square-feet, fully furnished. It's an urban contemporary design. And if you come down here, you will not ever believe this is affordable housing. It's absolutely beautiful," said executive director Rachel Hester.

The center will expand housing, job training, education and healthcare services for Nashville's homeless.
