## Room In The Inn Holds Ribbon Cutting Thursday

**NASHVILLE, Tenn.** - The ribbon cutting was held Thursday for the Room in the Inn Campus for Human Development.

The Comprehensive Center provides housing, meals, education, job training and healthcare services for the homeless.

The new \$13 million multi-purpose facility on 8th Avenue has shower and laundry facilities, Internet access and a library. It also has expanded care for those recovering from medical illnesses or injuries.

For the first time in history, Room in the Inn will offer 38 affordable housing apartments.

Governor Phil Bredesen and Metro Mayor Karl Dean were also in attendance. Self-guided tours are open to the public until 6 p.m. Thursday.
